

# WHAT IS A RAISED CROSSWALK?

A raised crosswalk is at the same level as the sidewalk. It provides a flat, even surface to walk across the street. Because it is raised, people crossing the street are more visible to drivers.

### Slowing down

Drivers need to slow and yield to people crossing. All crosswalks are painted with reflective striping, so they are visible at night.

# People crossing are more visible

Design prevents people from parking too close or on top of crosswalk, which would create a safety hazard

#### Location

Located in front of Senior Center entrance so people with disabilities have easy access to door
