

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Public Hearing and 30-day public comment period is being held for all interested persons relative to the **draft *Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA)* for property known as the PARKER AND TERRACE STREET DEVELOPMENT SITE CLEANUP PROJECT in Jamaica Plain (Boston), Massachusetts** (the Site).

The project is supported by a FY2022 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfields Cleanup Grant. The draft ABCA summarizes the findings of previous investigations conducted at the Site and presents a description of potential cleanup options. In addition, the draft ABCA compares the remediation options and presents a proposed cleanup plan for the Site. The 30-day comment period begins with the publishing of this announcement and will end on October 30, 2024. The public is encouraged to review and comment on the draft ABCA during the public comment period.
