I hereby transmit for your approval an Order authorizing the City of Boston to accept and expend the amount of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$120,000.00**) in the form of a grant, Harrison Albany Block Public Benefits Fund, awarded by Boston Redevelopment Authority to be administered by the Police Department.

**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND** Harrison Albany Block Public Benefits Fund FUNDS, AWARDED BY Boston Redevelopment Authority.

**WHEREAS**, the Boston Redevelopment Authority, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$120,000.00) would fund the purchase and installation of cameras at O'Day Park, Blackstone Square, and Franklin Square in the South End, under a Cooperation Agreement between MEPT/LMP GAMBRQ BUILDING LLC and the Boston Redevelopment Authority.
