Project Description:

This project is located in Mission Hill - 95 St. Alphonsis Street, Boston, MA 02120. Approved 6-story residential development featuring 115 new apartments. Apartments at Longwood II Residences would include 40 studios, 35 1-bedrooms, 10 1-bedrooms with dens and 30 2-bedrooms. 15 apartments at Longwood II Residences would be designated affordable including 5 studios, 6 1-bedrooms, and 4 2-bedrooms. Resident amenities would include a club room, a meeting room, a fitness center, a ground-floor outdoor courtyard, and a roof deck.

130 parking spaces, including 108 below-grade and 22 at-grade, would be provided on site for residents of both Longwood II Residences and The Longwood, an adjacent 14-story, 147-unit apartment building also owned by the proponent.

BRJP Highlights and Concerns:

- The projects overall employment percentages could use improvement in all monitored categories.
- The projects overall average payroll submission time is currently at 10 days with the following subcontractors negatively impacting the payroll submission average:

Wood & Wire Fence Co. – 76 days - After reviewing, the delinquent submissions were for temporary fencing related to the enabling portion of the work and should not be counted. Hours will be removed for those weeks.

- P.J. Dionne Co, Inc, 34 days submissions were timely, however was submitting under wrong Project ID #.
- 19 Boston residents have been reported so far. Only 3 of the 19 reported resident's residency remain unverified to date. (84%)

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Subcontractors, who are currently mobilized on site, should present a plan to maximize remaining resident and female hours. Below are the 5 subcontractors projected to perform the most hours in this current fiscal quarter.
 - East Coast Interiors
 - NER Construction
 - Aldon Electric
 - o Inner City Fire
 - PJ Dionne
- Certified payrolls need to be submitted within 7 business days so subcontractor's workforce can be monitored in a real time manner.
- Workers residency should be verified as soon as they arrive on site. A 90% Boston Resident verification rate is the standard.
- Quarterly workforce projections have been requested in an attempt to identify any deficiencies in meeting the employment standards.
