COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE

October 30, 2020

The Boston City Council's Committee on Ways and Means will hold a public hearing on **Monday, November 16, 2020 at 2:00 PM**. This hearing will be held virtually.

The subject of the hearing is:

Docket #0839, Order for a hearing regarding Boston Police overtime.

Docket #1039, Order for a hearing to discuss the City of Boston and Boston Police Department's oversight protocols for BPD overtime and to discuss ensuring effective oversight measures.

Docket #0839 was sponsored by Councilors Kenzie Bok, Andrea Campbell, and Matt O'Malley, and was referred to the Committee on July 8, 2020. Docket #1039 was sponsored by Councilor Ricardo Arroyo, and was referred to the Committee on October 7, 2020.

This enables the City Council to carry out its responsibilities while adhering to public health recommendations and ensuring public access to its deliberations through adequate, alternative means.
