## Openings/Service

- New grave/lots are sold to persons wishing to make arrangements for the immediate burial of a Boston resident only.
- The above rule does not apply to lots previously purchased, in which case the owner of the grave/lot may request that a person be interred therein whether or not they are residents of Boston.
- Minimum of 24 hour notice on all orders of interments.
- No interments will be made without a Board of Health permit and signed interment order signed by the proper persons.
- No interments will be made on Sundays or on the following holidays:

Patriots' Day  
Memorial Day  
Independence Day  
Labor Day  
Columbus Day  
Veterans' Day  
Thanksgiving Day  
Christmas Day

- All fees must be paid at or before any services are rendered.
- The General Superintendent may refuse to make an interment until a more expedient time or if the remains are to arrive at the

Cemetery after 3 p.m. or if too many funerals arrive at the same time.

- Cemetery will not be responsible for monuments or any flowers, flags, decorations, holders or other devices or receptacles placed on graves.
