## **Parks Department announces Charlestown virtual tree removal hearing**

In accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 87, the Boston Parks and Recreation Department will hold a virtual public hearing on Thursday, December 7, at 10 a.m. on a request to remove two public shade trees in Charlestown.

The request is for the removal of two Honey Locust trees measuring 2.5 inches and 3 inches dbh (diameter at breast height) at 30 Park Street in order to construct a raised planter and install three new trees.

The hearing will be held by the City of Boston's Tree Warden (or designee). Please note that the hearing will be a virtual meeting via ZOOM. The information for the ZOOM hearing is as follows:
