## BPHC Homeless Services Runs a Van Driving To and From Day Spaces

- Van service operates 7am – 3pm Monday through Friday.
- Route order: (1) St Francis House, (2) Women's Lunch Place, (3) Rosie's Place, (4) Day Engagement Center at Whittier, (5) Boston Living Center, (6) Victory Connector.
- The Van loops through the locations throughout the day (driver takes one hour lunch break).
- The van is labeled "Boston's Recovery Route."
- Sites have designated pick-up and drop-off marked by signage.
- Drivers do NOT drop clients off at other locations beyond the designated programs.
