

CHANDLER POND – CONSTRUCTION UPDATE 08/05/2024

Thank you for your interest in the Chandler Pond Improvement Project.



GENERAL INFORMATION:

- The Phase 1 work focuses on the pond shoreline along Lake Shore Road. This area was prioritized because of the steep slopes, making it vulnerable to erosion. In addition, there are areas throughout the park where we are addressing invasive vegetation.
- The majority of the work is anticipated to be complete in late September. The monitoring and treatment of Japanese Knotweed throughout the park will continue for the next couple years.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

- The contractor, SumCo Eco-consulting, has completed site preparation and vegetation clearing. The new planting will be installed in September when the temperatures are cooler. There will be only minor work happening on site until that time.
- Once the planting goes in, there will be protection fencing in place to allow the establishment of the plants. This fencing will be in place for up to 2-3 years.
