**AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND** FY25 State 911 Training Grant FUNDS, AWARDED BY MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security.

**WHEREAS**, the MA Executive Office Of Public Safety & Security, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds in the amount of FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-SEVEN CENTS (**\$445,865.77**) would fund the training and certification of Enhanced 911 telecommunications staff. Therefore be it
