


MEETING GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Present the final design for the greenway path, entry spaces, and amenities including drainage improvements.
- Respond to questions and comments from the community.



PROJECT SCHEDULE



- Single path at 12' seems narrow, can it be wider.
- Lighting updates needed and accent lighting should be considered.
- Concern was voiced that the runoff from the adjacent properties is a major contributor to the flooding.
- Gove Street place making opportunities.
- Entrance Special Pavers: Corner of Maverick and Orleans Street needs to be strengthened with pavers, signage, and placemaking strategies.
- Container storage for the deployable barrier would benefit from decorative painting.
- More trash cans.
- Prevent camping on-site.
- Signage can be helpful for wayfinding.
- Dog walkers should be accommodated.

EXISTING CONDITIONS - FLOODING

CAUSES OF STORMWATER FLOODING ON THE GREENWAY

- High water table and low infiltration rates
- Drainage pipes emptying into the Harbor (fill up at high tide)
- Low elevation of the Greenway
- Impervious surfaces and run off at adjacent properties
- Limited capacity of existing BPRD Pump

SOLUTIONS TO ADDRESSING STORMWATER FLOODING

- Green and grey infrastructure
- Tide gates (BWSC)
- Pump Station (BWSC)
- Decreased impervious surfaces
- Elevated portions of the pathway / bridging over wet areas
- Coordinating with abutters on containing runoff on site





GREENWAY DESIGN – LIGHTING UPDATES




- The design team conducted a nighttime walk and measured light levels along the Greenway noting areas of low light levels and reason for those.
 - Site wide lighting updates to convert all light fixtures to LED
- Tree pruning in select areas to allow for better site lighting
 - EXISTING LIGHT FIXTURE


- LIGHT POLE IN NEED OF REPLACEMENT






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
FLOOD MAP






