AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FY24 Police Reform and Equitable Justice Grant Program FUNDS, AWARDED BY Target Corporation.

WHEREAS, the Target Corporation, is being petitioned for the issuance of funds to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (**\$175,000.00**) would fund the Youth and Police Initiative (YPI), which provides police with the skills and tools necessary to understand and deal with troubled youth and gives troubled youth new ways to understand, perceive and deal with police authority.
