COMMITTEE HEARING NOTICE

November 21, 2024

The Boston City Council's Committee on Ways and Means will hold a hearing on Wednesday, November 27, 2024 at 9:30 am. This hearing will be held virtually.

The subjects of the hearing are:

Docket #1760, An order reducing the FY25 appropriation for the reserve for collective bargaining by one hundred seventy thousand, one hundred eighteen dollars (\$170,118).

Docket #1761, An order appropriating one hundred seventy thousand, one hundred eighteen dollars (\$170,118) to cover the FY25 cost items contained within the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Boston and NEPBA Patrol Officers.

These matters were sponsored by Mayor Michelle Wu and were referred to the Committee on November 20, 2024.

NOTICE: The Boston City Council may have a quorum participating due to standing committees of the City Council consisting of both voting and non-voting members. However, members participating in this duly posted meeting are participating and deliberating only in conjunction with the business of the standing committee.

Attendance In accordance with Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023 modifying certain requirements of the Open Meeting Law and relieving public bodies of certain requirements, including the requirement that public bodies conduct its meetings in a public place that is open and physically accessible to the public, the City Council will be conducting this hearing remotely. This enables the City Council to carry out its responsibilities while ensuring public access to its deliberations through adequate, alternative means.
