The City is seeking a skilled consultant or consultant team who can help shape and communicate plans for critical coastal resilience infrastructure.

The City of Boston is partnering with the US Army Corp of Engineers (USACE) on a plan to ensure the long term coastal resilience of Boston. Over the next three years, the USACE will be developing designs for coastal resilient infrastructure that reduces risk to the city for generations. The City is seeking a consultant or consultant team (Consultant), with experience in landscape architecture, who can help provide feedback on these designs and deliver renderings and models of these designs for further public engagement and feedback.

This project is part of a formal Coastal Storm Risk Management Study. Its results will be submitted to Congress in 2028 for approval, unlocking USACE collaboration and federal financing for further design and construction. The selected consultant will be awarded a **36-month contract**.
