


AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Safe, stable, affordable housing is a need across all Boston neighborhoods if the city is to remain a healthy and welcoming place for existing and new residents. Community Preservation Act (CPA) grant funding supports affordable housing for individuals or families with incomes at or below 100 percent of the area median income (AMI).

Through CPA, Boston seeks to leverage additional resources for housing, meet the measurable goals outlined in Housing Boston 2030, prevent loss of existing affordable units, and narrow the racial wealth and homeownership gap in the City.


