

HISTORIC PRESERVATION

Church of the Covenant Historic Preservation 2018

Back Bay

• 67 Newbury St, Boston, MA 02116

CPA Award: \$675,000

Description of Project:

Exterior masonry and roof on the South elevation, facing Newbury Street. Address problems around the entrance. Built in 1867 of Roxbury puddingstone in the Gothic Revival style, the building was designed by Richard M. Upton. With a distinctive interior, largely the work of Tiffany & Co., this building was one of the first churches to relocate to the new Back Bay.



CPA Award: \$306,700

Description of Project:

Restore five sets of entry doors, masonry, staircases, and vestibule. Replace steam pipe and part of the roof. This building was built in 1861 and designed by Alexander Rice Etsy. It was the first building completed on Newbury Street in Boston's newly filled Back Bay.





Roxbury Presbyterian Historic Preservation 2018

CPA Award: \$675,000

Description of Project:

Restoration of roof, masonry, rails, doors, windows and entry. The building was built in 1891, ten years after the formation of the congregation. It was designed by John C. Spofford and built of local Roxbury puddingstone in the Gothic style.



Description of Project:

Restoration & modernization and addition of accessibility Ramp. The Vilna Shul is a rare cultural organization in Beacon Hill, a living museum and cultural and community center for diverse audiences.



Description of Project:

Repair front entrance including stairs, handicapped access ramp, handrails, wood paneling and openings in the rear fence and building exterior. The building was built in 1848 and was designed by Gridley J.F. Brand. Originally the Josiah Quincy School. First school in the country to separate students by age and grade.





Upham's Corner Comfort Station Historic Preservation 2018

CPA Award: \$365,000

Description of Project:

Final gap funding to complete the restoration of the 1912 Comfort Station building in Uphams Corner a 1900-square-foot, severely distressed building that has been vacant for nearly 40 years. Built by Dorchester architect William Besarick, it served as public bathrooms for commuters traveling on an expanding streetcar network.





William Clapp House and Lemuel Clap House Historic Preservation 2018

CPA Award: \$51,200

Description of Project:

Final exterior improvements: restore doors and windows; paint exterior of barn and carriage house; repair and paint picket fence and gates. The Captain Lemuel Clap House was constructed from 1765-1767. The adjacent William Clapp House was built in 1806. The family operated a large and successful Dorchester tannery.





Schooner Roseway Historic Preservation 2018

Grant Award: \$250,000

Description of Project:

Complete restoration of historic ship. To keep the ship seaworthy; replace the 100-year-old horntimber. Built in 1925 for Harold Hathaway, Roseway is a wooden gaff-rigged schooner.



Grant Award: \$200,000

Description of Project:

Restore Johnson Gates and entrance paths at this main entrance to the Back Bay Fens, part of the Emerald Necklace. The Johnson Gates were built in 1902 and erected in 1905. The gates were designed by Guy Lowell, who was also the architect of Boston's Museum of Fine Arts.





Copp's Hill Burying Ground Historic Preservation 2018

CPA Award: \$104,400

Description of Project:

Conserve slate grave markers that date from 1659 in Copp's Hill Burying Ground on the Freedom Trail



Description of Project:

Restore masonry on 1912 frieze of bears holding the City seal adorning the former Zoo exhibit in Franklin Park.





Eliot Church Historic Preservation 2018

CPA Award: \$100,000

Description of Project:

Repair the masonry at the entrance of the building. Designed by J. Williams Beal, this building was built in 1873 out of local Roxbury puddingstone in the High Victorian Gothic style.

CPA Award: \$150,000

Description of Project:

Restore original center door, brownstone steps, railings, lighting, brick and iron entry gates, and pavement. This building was built in 1804 and is the fifth meetinghouse built on this site. The site of the building has been in continuous use since early English settlers built the first meetinghouse on it in 1632.



Description of Project:

Restoration of the perimeter-wrought iron fence & gates, roof, cemetery paths & walls, lighting, protective glass, and cemetery stones. This building, built in 1819 in the Gothic Revival style, is the oldest Catholic building in Massachusetts.



Roof repair to South End House, founded in 1892 as a way to alleviate poverty for emancipated slaves, new immigrants, and rural laborers.



Window conservation, carpentry repairs, repair of the brownstone steps at the front door, and fabrication / installation of iron railings. Built in 1796 in the Federal style, this house is the last surviving mansion in Bowdoin Square, Boston's West End neighborhood.

Description of Project:

Restore crumbled and fenced stairs as well as the main entrance on Boylston Street. This building was built in 1861 and designed by Arthur Delevan Gilman. It was the first public building and first church in Back Bay. It is home to a collection of sixteen, 9-foot tall windows designed by artist and designer Louis Comfort Tiffany.





First Baptist Church Tower Historic Preservation 2019

Description of Project:

To stabilize, restore, and weatherproof the First Baptist Church steeple. This building was built in 1872 in the Romanesque style and was known as the Brattle Square Church.

Description of Project:

To repoint the brick on the Salah Hall building on Thompson Island used for STEM education by thousands of Boston Public Schools students. Salah Hall was built in 1909. Since the 1830's, Thompson Island has served as a place of education for youth.

Description of Project:

Restore the exterior of Memorial Hall, a 1791 mansion serving veterans and the larger community, and originally the home of President John Adams' Secretary of War.



Description of Project:

Major renovation of the Pierce Building at Upham's Corner, a cornerstone of the new arts district. The site of the present Columbia Square Pierce Building is where Amos Upham, for whom the Upham's Corner neighborhood is named, opened a dry goods store in 1804 that was run by three generations of Upham's into the mid-1890s.





Faneuil Hall Archaeology: Laboratory & Exhibit Historic Preservation 2019



Description of Project:

Create a public laboratory to process and catalog 17th and 18th century artifacts from beneath Faneuil Hall showing Boston's role in the trans-Atlantic slavetrade and its emergence as a global marketplace. Also included is the construction of temperature and moisture controlled displays to protect the artifacts and put them in public view.



Description of Project:

To help with major repairs to HVAC and other systems at the Old State House, one of the oldest and most visited sites on the Freedom Trail. Built in 1713 in the Georgian style, the Old State House was the seat of the Massachusetts General Court until 1798 and Boston's City Hall from 1830 to 1841.

Description of Project:

Restoration of key structural components of the Nantucket Lightship LV-112 to ensure the integrity of the ship's hull below the waterline.

Through a Community Preservation Act Grant, the City Archives transcribing 160 handwritten volumes of General Registers of Women Voters from the City of Boston (August to October 1920). The transcribed data will be available to the public as a fully searchable and sortable excel spreadsheet

The Mary Eliza Project is working closely with the City Archives to research people and places connected to the voter registrations. This includes some of the women voters themselves, and telling their stories here along the way.

The Mary Eliza Project is named in honor of Mary Eliza Mahoney (1845-1926). The pioneering African American nurse and civil rights activist is one of the many Boston women who registered to vote in 1920.
