

Columbia Road Community Advisory Team

The eighth Community Advisory Team (CAT) meeting took place on Tuesday, January 16, from 6:00 to 7:30 PM.

The January CAT meeting focused on key project updates and engagement activities.

In the first half of the meeting, CAT members received an update on the **Early Action Project**. The **Public Works Department** has begun installing **painted medians**, and the project team provided an overview of the progress made so far.

The second segment of the meeting highlighted **community engagement efforts**. A team member shared key lessons learned from the **community feedback collected in 2024**, followed by a brief discussion where CAT members had the opportunity to ask questions and reflect on these insights.

In the final part of the meeting, the project team led an interactive activity to demonstrate how **community feedback is shaping the design process**. They introduced a simple guide outlining **what success could look like for the project** and invited CAT members to share their thoughts and ideas.

These discussions continue to inform the project's approach, ensuring that the community's vision plays a central role in the design of Columbia Road.
