ORDERED: That the City of Boston, acting by and through its Transportation Commissioner, be, and hereby is, authorized, in accordance with Section 53A of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to accept and expend a grant from MCAF Winthrop, LLC, in an amount that shall not exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) pursuant to the 115 Winthrop Square Redevelopment Project Cooperation Agreement for the purpose of funding a bus rapid transit plan as described in the 115 Winthrop Square Redevelopment Project's Transportation Access Plan Agreement.
